WINNING WWI – The story of the Hejaz Railway and Lawrence of Arabia.
EVENING IN A BEDOUIN TENT, in which you practise Bedouin etiquette using authentic artefacts to play roles as family members and visitors arriving at sunset.

SEVEN DAYS IN TIBET – 4WD to Lhasa and back over Everest. DOWN THE NILE BY FELUCCA – Aswan to Luxor. CONTRASTS IN INDIA – north and south, mosques and temples. A GERIATRIC HIPPY'S JOURNEY ROUND THE WORLD ROUND NEW ZEALAND BY CAMPERVAN ROUND AUSTRALIA BY BUS ROUND AMERICA UNDER CANVAS

FOLLOWING THE FOOTSTEPS OF ST PAUL - from Damascus through Turkey to Ephesus and across to Philippi, Athens and Corinth, we retrace St Paul's journeys. FOLLOWING THE VIKINGS – from Norway to Iceland, Greenland and beyond. THE SEARCH FOR THE SOURCE OF THE NILE – the amazing story of 19C adventurers Burton & Speke, Livingstone & Stanley. WHERE NOW? A history of mapping North Hampshire (needs internet connection).

Returned to North Waltham, I've become the village archivist, helped set up a history society and become an adult education lecturer and writer, so can also offer: RESEARCHING YOUR FAMILY HISTORY or HOW TO DATE YOUR HOUSE LIVING WITH JANE – a gardener's view of the life and times of Jane Austen. STEVENTON – a tour of Jane Austen's village, either through slides or a guided walk, which can end with home-made cream tea or pub lunch to make a real outing. STEVENTON MANOR IN THE 1930s – silent film showing Fane family life. NORTH WALTHAM – a slideshow tracing the development of my village OR a guided walk around my village &/OR "Voices of North Waltham", a DVD of residents' memories telling the story of change in our community 1935-65.
